Maastricht University India Scholarship (University of Madras)

Maastricht University offers two full one year master scholarships to students from the University of Madras for the year 2011-2012. Maastricht University is looking for talented high potential students with a focused interest in a specific field of study as well as an interest and maturity to study abroad.

The scholarships will be awarded within the framework of cooperation between Maastricht University and the University of Madras for the purpose of assisting talented Indian students to pursue a master degree at Maastricht University and are subject to a set number of conditions listed below. The recipients can commence their studies at Maastricht University as of 1st September 2011.

Who is eligible?

Applicants must be accepted to a Maastricht University Master programme of the student's choice, according to the admission criteria set for each programme and may be no older than 35 years at the start of the academic year, starting September 2011.

Applicants have to meet all requirements for obtaining a Dutch visa ('MVV' residence permit). Applicants also need to be a registered student at the University of Madras, Chennai at the time of application.

Amount of the scholarship

The scholarship is in principle awarded for the duration of the programme, with a maximum of 12 months per academic year. However if a two year master's programme is involved, the UM University's Scholarship Committee may decide to award the scholarship for a maximum period of 24 months.

The scholarship allowance covers the living expenses (accommodation and additional costs) per month (with a maximum of 800 Euro per month), insurance, visa costs, tuition fee (with a maximum of 11.500 Euro) and refund of travel expenses return ticket India – Europe (maximum of 1000 Euro) one return journey only.

All costs are either paid for or arranged by the Student Services Centre of Maastricht University.

UM SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE

To receive a scholarship or other financial aid you must first follow the application procedure. For UM scholarships you can apply directly to the faculty of your choice. For external scholarships and financial aid, however, you must first contact the relevant organisation or institution. Here you will find the application procedures both for UM and external financial aid.

UM scholarships

Master's application:

The application procedure for master's programmes can vary. Thus, it is important to carefully read the information on how to apply in the master's programme section of the website.

Scholarship application:

To obtain a scholarship, you must be accepted to a master's programme. The scholarship application form should be sent to the faculty contact person. We advise you to send both applications (i.e. for the master's programme and the scholarship) at the same time. Faculty staff will contact the Scholarship Office and provide them with a list of students who they feel should receive a UM scholarship. Only students who have personally applied for a UM scholarship will be included. The Scholarship Office will contact successful applicants in mid-May.

External scholarships/financial aid

The application procedure for scholarships from external organisations or institutions differs from that for UM scholarships. You should visit the website of the particular financial aid programme to read about their application procedure, selection process and terms and conditions.

Under "Find your scholarship" in the menu on the left, you will find information about all scholarship and financial aid programmes at UM.

Other non-UM related Scholarships

MEL Scholarship Trust Fund – Master’s and bachelor’s degree in Business administration and management, study.

The MEL Scholarship Trust Fund (STF) may award up to six scholarships per year to citizens or residents of: The Netherlands; Scandinavia; USA; Canada; Japan; Greece; Rest of the World. Partial or full scholarships are awarded on the basis of an essay competition. Winners of the competition join MEL for the academic year the scholarship is awarded, and the scholarship cannot be transferred to another academic year.

Students who have been admitted to the MEL Programme may submit an essay to compete for the scholarship. The topic depends on the region the student comes from.

Value and purpose of grant: The purpose of the scholarship is to encourage promising students to take part in MEL. Each year a number of full tuition or part-scholarships are awarded.

NFP Fellowships for Master's Degree Programmes – Master’s and Bachelor’s degree in all fields, study

Candidates are eligible for a fellowship only if they have been admitted to their chosen master’s degree programme and meet all the criteria. PHD Scholarships

WOTRO Integrated Programmes – PhD, all fields, research

The Integrated Programme (IP) scheme is aimed at supporting excellent problem-oriented interdisciplinary research to the benefit of development and societal issues in the South. The research should lead to new insights, applications, theories or breakthroughs in current knowledge or understanding while addressing developmental issues.

Applications must be formally submitted by a senior researcher with a PhD degree, working at a Dutch university, a NWO or Royal Netherlands Academy institute or at an international institute for higher education based in the Netherlands. A senior researcher with a PhD degree from the partner institute in the developing country should be co-applicant and member of the coordinating team.

Grant information

Value and purpose of grant : WOTRO offers grants for medium-sized research programmes of max. € 700,000, integrated sets of projects conducted by PhD or postdoc researchers from the Netherlands and developing countries. Budget includes research and personnel costs, as well as costs for joint programme activities.

Grant award period: max 5 years.

Who can apply?

Applications must be formally submitted by a senior researcher with a PhD degree, employed by a NWO recognised grant recipient or by an international centre for scientific education based in the Netherlands. A senior researcher from the partner organisation in the developing country concerned with a PhD degree should be the co-applicant and a member of the coordinating team.

. The procedure is split into two stages with a preliminary and final application. It is compulsory to submit a preliminary application. Awarded programmes can usually start one year after submitting the preliminary application.

Application procedure

The preliminary applications are evaluated and ranked by a Scientific Advisory Committee, supported by an evaluation on the relevance for development drawn up by a Societal Panel. The final applications will be assessed on the basis of peer-review, the Panel's comments and the applicants' responses to these. The WOTRO Board takes the final decision on funding.

Among others: be a national of and working in of one of the developing countries on the NFP country list valid at the time of application; be a mid-career professional; offer proof that the PhD will be pursued according to a 'sandwich' or 'picnic' model; have been unconditionally admitted as a PhD student by one of the designated 21 Dutch institutions; be nominated by the employer; not be employed by a large industrial, commercial and/or multinational firm; speaking and writing the language of instruction; be available for the entire period of the programme and be physically and mentally able to take part in the entire programme; declare that they will return to their home country immediately after the study programme has ended.
